OVERALL COLLEGE RATE: 80% of the graduates are employed.

SUCCESS RATE: 92% of the graduates are employed, continuing their education or both.

62% of the graduates are working in their field; the average (related) salary is \$32,619.

75% of the graduates are working in the State of Maine

93% of the employed graduates are working in the State of Maine.

49% of the graduates who are working full-time, part-time or working while continuing their education, are working in Aroostook County.

61% of the employed graduates are working in Aroostook County  
175 total degrees were conferred on 158 students

The median weighted salary for graduates who are employed full-time in their field is \$29,065. The average weighted salary for the same group is \$31,942.
