50% of the graduates are working in their field; the average (related) salary is \$36,627.

95% of the employed graduates are working in the State of Maine.

76% of the employed graduates are working in Aroostook County  
204 total degrees were conferred on 199 students

SUCCESS RATE: 88% of the graduates are employed, continuing their education or both.

70% of the graduates are working in the State of Maine

56% of the graduates who are working full-time, part-time or working while continuing their education, are working in Aroostook County.

The median weighted salary for graduates who are employed full-time in their field is \$28,865. The average weighted salary for the same group is \$36,924.
