NMCC & Partners Receive HEAPP Grant to Promote Alcohol Awareness

Northern Maine Community College, the University of Maine at Presque Isle, the Aroostook County Action Program and the Presque Isle Police Department are collectively the recipient of a grant from the Higher Education Alcohol Prevention Partnership (HEAPP). The grant focuses on increased law enforcement related to under-age drinking as well as the dissemination of alcohol information and prevention activities.

"The timing of the grant is critically important as we approach the holiday season," said Dr. William Egeler, NMCC dean of students. "All of our efforts related to prevention are done in an effort to prevent a tragedy from occurring. We greatly appreciate the efforts of all of our partners in the securing of and executions of these grant activities."
