## NMCC to Host Presentation on A.C.T. Wilson

The Presque Isle Historical Society is continuing its series of presentations on key happenings that have shaped the history of the region. Two sessions remain in the series which began earlier this year. Both are open to the public at no charge and will be held in the Edmunds Conference Center.

Campus and community members are invited to learn more about Allen C.T. Wilson (1866-1952) on Wednesday, September 5, at 5:30 p.m. He was a local business man, farmer and family man who was very involved in the Presque Isle community. Wilson served on the City Council as well as in the Maine House of Representatives and the Senate. He was instrumental in Presque Isle successfully building the Northern Maine Sanatorium and, because of his efforts, one of the main buildings was named in his honor. In fact, the sign that was on the building will be formally presented to the Historical Society on September 5 by the Wilson family.

"Engaging people in local history leads to a greater sense of community pride and is integral to the mission of the Presque Isle Historical Society. We are proud to continue our partnership with Northern Maine Community College to offer these presentations as NMCC has had a rich heritage of serving our community for over fifty years," said Kimberly Smith of the P.I. Historical Society, who is leading the sessions.

This marks the third presentation in this series. Earlier this year, sessions were held on the history of the Presque Isle Hospital and the Northern Maine Fair. The series concludes in December with a historical look at ice harvesting in Presque Isle.
