Jen Blood is author of the bestselling Erin Solomon mystery series. She has been awarded the Awesome Indies Seal of Quality for her first novel, *All the Blue-Eyed Angels* and received Honorable Mention at the New England Festival of Books for the second novel in the Erin Solomon Series, *Sins of the Father*, which takes place in northern Maine. The third novel in the series, *Southern Cross*, was released in March. Jen earned an MFA in Creative Writing/ Popular Fiction from the University of Southern Maine, and leads seminars on writing, social media, and online marketing for authors. She lives in midcoast Maine.

#### Wednesday, April 17 ~ Anne Britting Oleson

Anne Britting Oleson is a Maine poet whose work has been published widely on three continents--North America, Europe, and Asia. Oleson earned her MFA at the Stonecoast program of the University of Southern Maine. She has published two chapbooks, *The Church of St. Materiana* (2007) and *The Beauty of It* (2010), and submits work for publication every day. For twenty-five years she has taught public school, and she lives in central Maine with her family.







#### Wednesday, April 24 ~ Monica Wood

Monica Wood is the author of When We Were the Kennedys: A Memoir from Mexico, Maine, a New England indie bestseller; #1 indie bestseller in Maine; a national Indie Next pick; and an Oprah's 2012 Summer Reading pick. Monica is also the author of four works of fiction, most recently Any Bitter Thing, which spent twenty-one weeks on the American Booksellers Association extended bestseller list and was named a Book Sense Top Ten pick. Her other fiction includes Ernie's Ark, Secret Language, and My Only Story, a finalist for the Kate Chopin Award.
