Annual "TD Bank Golf Tournament to benefit NMCC Foundation" raises more than \$23,000

Aroostook County - Northern Maine Community College students will be the beneficiaries of more than \$23,000 in scholarship funds raised through the TD Bank Golf Tournament to benefit the NMCC Foundation held on August 8 at the Aroostook Valley Country Club in Fort Fairfield. This marks the tournament's most successful year to date.

Just over one hundred golfers teed off for the annual scramble. A dinner and silent auction followed play at AVCC. This year's auction featured a number of gift certificates from local businesses, some special items such as autographed sports memorabilia, a hot-air balloon ride and, courtesy of TD Bank, tickets to a Boston Bruins game. The auction raised about \$5000.

Second place net went to Steve Clark, Bill Casavant and Bill Egeler, with a score of 57.8. Third low net went to John McCrea, Larry Gardner and Robert Osterblom, with a score of 58.2.

Other awards were presented to golfers for their achievements during the day. Closest to the pin for the men was Bob Bruce on hole 8 and Bill Molloy on hole 15. Closest to the pin for the women was Kathy Roy on hole 8. The longest drive winner on the 18th hole was Steve Clark. Best dressed was presented to Marjolaine Dube.
