NMCC STUDENT RECEIVES A \$1000 MeHEAF SCHOLARSHIP

The Maine Higher Education Assistance Foundation (MeHEAF) was founded in the 1950's by a group of banks, businesses, community organizations and individuals. It awards twelve \$1,000 scholarships to the best and the brightest students in a business or related field from these Maine colleges: Husson University, Maine Community College System, St. Joseph's College, Thomas College, the University of Maine at Augusta, Farmington, Fort Kent, Machias, Orono, Presque Isle, the University of Southern Maine, and the University of New England.

Annette Derry was picked from NMCC primarily on the basis of her great academic standing. The other criteria necessary for the scholarship consideration are upper class enrollment in a business-related program, graduation from a Maine high school, and eligibility for financial aid. Annette graduated from Caribou High School and plans to further her education by pursuing a four year degree. Receiving this scholarship will support that dream.

While attending a breakfast hosted by the Maine Banker's Association, Annette received her scholarship and was congratulated by several members of the local banking community and three State legislators.
