

Question 5 will invest \$900,000 in Northern Maine Community College to convert Aroostook Hall into classrooms, labs, and offices that will enable the college to expand its allied health programs. Funds will also enable energy efficiencies and the purchase of new classroom equipment.

Question 5 on the November 5th statewide ballot includes \$15.5 million to expand the capacity of Maine's seven community colleges to prepare more Maine people for high wage/high demand jobs. The funds will enable the colleges to expand degree programs that are most requested by both students and employers.

If approved by voters, the bond funds will include \$900,000 for Northern Maine Community College. The funds would enable NMCC to convert Aroostook Hall into classrooms, labs, and offices that will allow the college to expand its allied health programs including Community Paramedicine, Emergency Medical Services and Health Information Technology. Funds would also be used for energy efficiencies and the purchase of new classroom equipment.

"NM plays a vital role in the economic development of Aroostook County by training tomorrow's workforce using the most up-to-date technology and we consult with industry leaders who recommend program improvements," according to NMCC President Timothy Crowley. "Since health care jobs are projected to grow in this region it's vital that we keep up with the demand. Some monies from Bond #5 will also be set aside for the Precision Metals Manufacturing program—another area for potential job increases. We need to grow the workforce in these areas if we are to attract new jobs to the region. This bond is essential to the growth of Aroostook County."
