2014 Maine Government Summer Internship Opportunity

The 2014 Maine Government Summer Internship Program is a full-time, paid work experience in a state or municipal agency, from May 27 to August 15, 2014. The program is designed to provide talented college students an opportunity to participate in and contribute to Maine government. This year, internships will be available in state government and a select number in local/county government.

Maine residents are encouraged to apply. Non-residents who are attending a Maine college may also participate if you have completed two years of college. The **deadline** for student applications is **Saturday, March 1, 2014**.

Northern Maine Community College Named Among Top 150 in U.S.

NMCC has been cited by the Aspen Institute College Excellence program as one of the nation's top 150 community colleges for its commitment to student success and community college excellence. The designation means NMCC is eligible to compete for the Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence and \$1 million in prize funds.

The Aspen Prize, awarded every two years, is the nation's signature recognition of high achievement and performance from among more than 1,000 community colleges in the country. The program recognizes institutions for exceptional student outcomes in four areas: student learning, certificate and degree completion, employment and earnings, and high levels of access and success for minority and low-income students.

The Aspen Institute identified the top 150 community colleges through an assessment of institutional performance, improvement, and equity on student retention and completion measures. A selection committee of former community college presidents and faculty, along with respected researchers and policy experts, will select ten finalists.



"We are extremely proud to be selected and counted among this elite group of community colleges which brings well-deserved attention to our exceptional faculty," NMCC President Timothy Crowley reacted.

"We are grateful that the Aspen program honors community colleges for the important role we have in society. Nearly half of America's college students, some seven million, attend community colleges across the country. NMCC is anxious to compete to be among the ten Aspen finalists."
