SkillsUSA Welding Competition Held at NMCC

Northern Maine Community College hosted the welding and metal fabrication portion of the SkillsUSA Maine Championships on February 28. A team of high school students from the Van Buren Regional Technology Center and two teams of college students from NMCC participated in the competition. Remaining competitions will be held in Bangor at the United Technologies Center and Eastern Maine Community College on March 13 and 14.

To begin, teams were given blueprints and welding procedure specifications for a shop cart and were allowed six and a half hours to fabricate the cart using only the limited materials that were provided. The blueprints were created by Ben Sipe who is a student in the NMCC Computer-Aided Drafting Program. Teams were judged on time management, ability to follow blueprints and the quality and craftsmanship of the welds in addition to several other criteria.

"For the high school students, this experience provides a glimpse of what it is like to attend college and interact with students who are further along in their education," said Gary Milton, head judge and welding teacher at Van Buren Regional Technology Center. "The high school students compete directly against college-level students so the pressure is on to not only finish the project in the time allowed, but to produce a product that meets the standards for industrial usage."

The winners of the welding and metal fabrication competition will be announced during the closing ceremonies on March 14 at the Cross Center in Bangor.
