University of Maine Orono Donates 113' GE Turbine Blade to NMCC

On March 14, Cianbro Corporation employees delivered a wind turbine blade to the NMCC campus. The wind turbine blade assembly was previously used by the University of Maine at Orono, Advanced Composite Structures Laboratory, for initial evaluation of the newly constructed composite structures test equipment. Upon completion of the test equipment evaluation, Red Webster, from Cianbro Corporation, called to see if the blade assembly would be a valuable addition for blade-inspection and repair-training activities at NMCC. The blade assembly was accepted for use in the Wind Power Technology (WPT) program as well as the Automotive Collision Repair program which will be able to make composite inspection and repair services to the blade.
