



## NMCC is Going Tobacco Free Poster Contest



Northern Maine Community College will be a tobacco-free campus beginning **September 2, 2014**. We are seeking your help in developing a poster that will be used to let the campus community know that the change is coming and when it will occur. The winning poster will be displayed throughout campus and prizes will be awarded.

### Theme

Northern Maine Community College is going tobacco-free!

### Guidelines

1. Poster must contain the following information:
  - a. Northern Maine Community College logo
  - b. Tobacco-Free beginning September 2, 2014 (including all tobacco products)
  - c. Smoking in personal vehicles on campus is prohibited
  - d. NMCC will help tobacco users who want to quit
2. Posters must be 11 x 17 portrait layout.
3. Posters must incorporate creative and original artwork and ideas. Depictions of cartoon, video game, and movie/television characters; celebrities; movie themes; do not constitute creativity and originality.
4. Posters should not be laminated or mounted on mat board. Also, do not staple, glue, or tape entry forms to the backs of posters.
5. Do not include your name or other identifying information on the front of your poster.
6. Students may use a variety of media, such as computer, watercolor, paint, pen and ink, markers, etc.
7. Pictures from magazines and other print media, or any other copyrighted brand or product images will not be accepted.
8. Attach (using paperclip) the official poster contest entry form to the poster. Please do not staple, tape, or glue this form to the poster.
9. Amateurs only may enter.
10. Failure to comply with the guidelines could result in disqualification of the poster.
