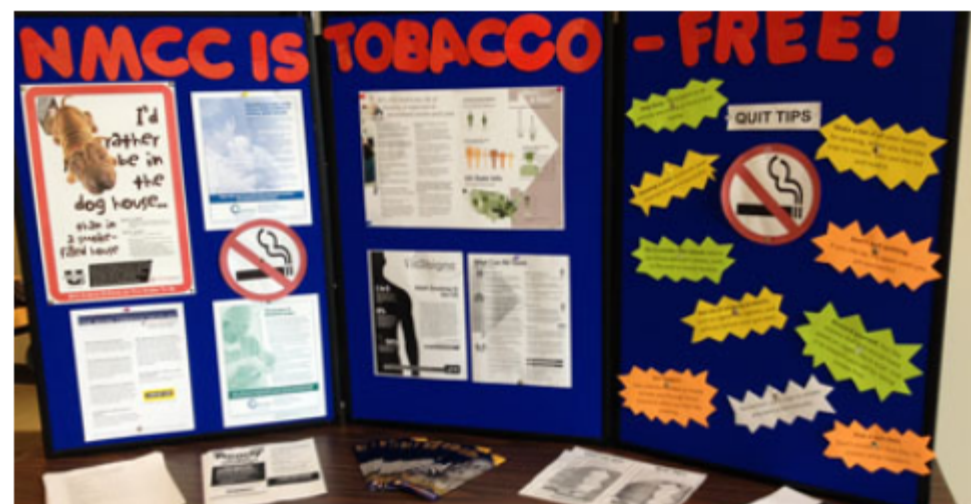
Hartford High School
