Peter Goheen – Active Shooter Video – In 2015 the FBI developed a training video intended for law enforcement, EMS personnel, and firefighters on best practice methods for an active shooter situation. This video was shown to the cabinet members in hopes to gain insight on developing a process to deal with an active shooter. The video highlighted the steps involved as being neutralize the shooter, help the injured, set up a victim help station, interview witnesses, work with the media and retrospect.

After viewing the video, President Crowley asked the group for their thoughts. The following are comments made:

- Where is the nearest mobile command state police
- It would take a long time to have support people here
- The plan we have is a small part of what we need and clarification is needed about people's roles
- Unprepared
- Positive relationship development and doing what you're best at doing; not what you might want to be doing.
- Parents trying to reach their child may actually put them in danger by calling
- Would need support set up for victims and their families afterward
- Communication with area schools and law enforcement vital

<u>Barry Ingraham</u> - Safety Items Report – need to set a date and time to meet. Also need to discuss training and training records.

Beth Hummel – Rob Nadeau from the System Office will be on campus on November 21 to conduct an informational meeting on overtime and comp time. A reminder will be sent out.

<u>Sue Bernard</u> - There will be an Employee Longevity Awards and Thanksgiving Luncheon on Tuesday, November 22 in the Edmunds Conference Center. Awards are grouped by a number of years. A copy of the program will be forwarded to administrators.
