- Thanked Dottie for information on committees. He made only a few adjustments and will try to
 distribute Wednesday so that everyone can be in place over next two weeks. Can ATD and
 Retention committees be combined? We will wait until the ATD work ends, then combine
 people on those committees. Tim says the Achieving the Dream team wrote a nice letter
 assessing our work when they left a couple of weeks ago—they are happy with our progress.

Bill--Navigator position has been filled: Ashley Hall; she will start on September 10th.

- Enrollment –no shows are being purged, new students are showing up. A couple of manageable student issues. Compared to last year we are slightly up, but expect even numbers.
- Mike says we will be down compared to budget. He budgeted 90 for housing and we have 83.
 Final number will depend on how dual enrollment comes in. Concurrent enrollment is not all counted yet.
- Bill--A couple of new schools downstate may be joining us for concurrent enrollment.

Mike—Board approved budgets are in Jenzabar. First set of reports should be ready at the close of August.

- The Foundation audit is done; David Alward will be attending the Foundation Executive Committee meeting in September to present the findings—clean audit.
- Regular college audits are ongoing...lots of questions, but should be complete for the Board.
- Ran final student charges on Friday. He believes we will be a little off budget for room and board
 and credit hours but not worried since he was conservative in budgeting in those areas for the
 spring.
- Currently, Ed Wright's budget is embedded in CED budget. System will send funds for this
 position, office and other expenses (\$200K was requested) and it will be set up in separate
 account.

Dottie--She and AJ are working on LPN proposal, which should be done this afternoon.

- Received draft of MCCS viewbook –Corrections have been sent.
- Griffin, Don and Leah are working on Mechanized Logging operation graduation.
