Presque Isle Light Parade

Once again, NMCC will have a float in the annual Presque Isle Light Parade, which is taking place this Saturday, December 1, at 7:00 p.m. in downtown Presque Isle. The parade starts at the corner of North St. and Main St. (by Katahdin Trust Company) and ends at UMPI.

We are looking for volunteers to help with the float...both children and adults. For those who would like to help, please plan to arrive on North Street around 6:30 p.m. We will make every attempt to get our entry to the start of the line-up early and hope to be first in line. Either way - look for the big bed with the banner "T'was The Night Before Christmas" above. Please dress appropriately. It looks like it will be a cold evening.

Children under 12 can ride on the float. Please bundle your children up in snow suits with warm mittens, a hat and warm boots. If possible, please have the children who will ride on the float/bed wear, over their snow suits, oversized night wear i.e.) pajamas, nightgown, etc. to go with the theme.

For those over 12, we would greatly appreciate help with passing out the over 1,000 books collected for distribution by Colleen Harmon, Peggy O'Kane and others. The NMCC EMS Ambulance will be our "Book Mobile." The books will be stored in the back of the ambulance, which will follow our float, and will be prepared for you to give out along the route.

Student Shannon Smart has graciously agreed to be the story reader on the float and will read along with a pre-taped recording of "T'was The Night Before Christmas" that will play repeatedly as we make our way down Main Street.

The float is looking great! Please be sure to extend a sincere thank you to Guy Jackson and his students for building our bed frame - which is the base of the float.
