 Spouses of NMCC students/employees receive 25% off all Daily Lift Ticket prices when accompanying an NMCC student/employee to Big Rock.


✤ Children living at the home of NMCC students/ employees receive 25% off all Daily Lift Ticket prices when accompanying an NMCC student/employee to Big Rock.

Important Notice Regarding Firearms, Firearm Storage on Campus

During the last Maine Community College System Board of Trustees meeting, a new policy was enacted which **prohibits the possession on, and discharge of, firearms near College property**. This action was taken pursuant to a new law passed last session by the Maine Legislature in recognition of the dangers posed by the accidental discharge of a firearm on or near the College, and following the recommendation of law enforcement officials.

Locally, this means that firearms, concealed or in plain view, are prohibited from all campus property. Resident students who have stored firearms or other weapons with the College security staff must remove them from campus by the end of this semester (12/21/07.)

The Presque Isle Police Department will actively look for weapons in all vehicles on campus during their routine campus passes. Anyone violating this policy will be subject to all appropriate actions.
