NMCC Student Senate invites community to April 10 show on campus featuring hypnotist Ronny Romm

Aroostook County - The Student Senate at Northern Maine Community College is sponsoring an evening of demonstrations of E.S.P. and hypnosis by entertainer Ronny Romm, that is open to the public, on Thursday, April 10 at 6:30 p.m. in the NMCC College gymnasium.
