Students Invited to Senate Meetings

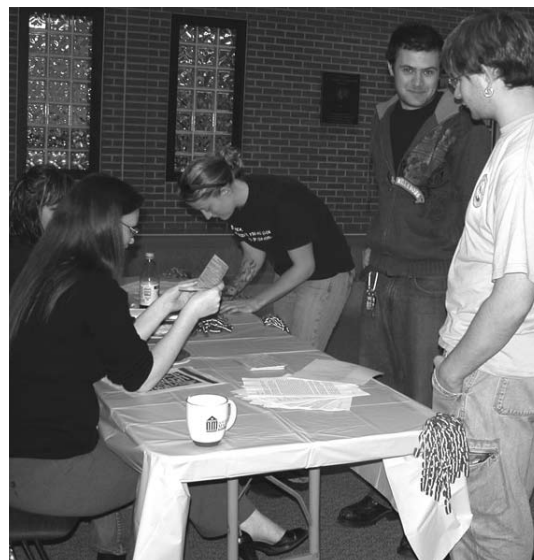
