

Campus Invited to Grand Opening Celebration of Allied Health Simulation Center

The campus community is invited to join County healthcare leaders and community members as well as officials from Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Maine as we celebrate the grand opening of a first-of-its-kind allied health simulation center in the region on Tuesday, October 7.

The ceremony will begin at 1:00 p.m. in the Edmunds Conference Center with remarks by NMCC President Timothy Crowley and Dan Corcoran, president of Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield in Maine. The Anthem Foundation contributed \$100,000 toward the project last fall through a gift to NMCC's Campaign for the County's College.

The event will feature a demonstration using the patient simulators led by NMCC nursing and allied health faculty that will be broadcast from the simulation center on the second floor of the Edmunds building to the conference center. An official ribbon cutting ceremony for the center will follow and small group tours of the new facility offered.
