Did You Get the Message?

The NMCC physical plant and technology office and development office coordinated and sent a test message to all contact methods (cell phones, home phones, email, etc.) registered in the Instant Alert system on Thursday, November 13, at 2:30 pm.

There were some concerns as more than 200 of the devices were not delivered to, due to incorrect information provided. Please take a moment to verify ALL of your contact information is correct by following these steps:

- Log into the portal https://portal.nmcc.edu
- Click on the 'General Info' resource (half way down the middle column)
- In the 'Instant Alert Contacts' window, verify all contact methods listed are correct
- If updating is needed, please click the 'Update' button in the contacts window (not to be confused with the 'Update Info' button above)
- Fill in the correct information on the 'Instant Alert Contact Updates' page and click the 'Send' button

It is important that you take two or three minutes to update this information as soon as possible!

In the event of an emergency situation or school closing at NMCC, Instant Alert will be used to broadcast the message to you as quickly and efficiently as possible. If the system does not have correct information, you may miss these important messages! Your safety and well being is important to us, please be sure to keep your information updated!
