### **Creative Writers Reading Series to Begin**

A Creative Writers Reading Series will take place at NMCC in April in honor of both National Community College Month and National Poetry Month. Three noon-time sessions will be held in the library featuring readings from both a guest writer as well as students from the College. The series, coordinated by instructor Jan Grieco, is free and open to the public.

Grieco herself will kick-off the first session in the series, featuring fiction writing, on April 9. Grieco is a former journalist who earned an MFA in fiction from the University of Southern Maine's Stonecoast program, and is a member of the Board of Directors for Maine Writers' and Publishers' Alliance. Her nonfiction work has been published in *Port City Life, Portland Magazine, Travel* 



*Holiday* and other regional magazines, and her fiction has been published in *iris*, *Cracked Lenses* and excerpted in *Portland Magazine*. In 2005 she was recognized as one of New England's most significant emerging writers by PEN New England. As a faculty member at NMCC, she teaches English Composition, Creative Writing and Mass Communications. She has recently completed her first novel, and lives in Perham with her husband and a pair of speckled German shorthair pointers.

The series continues on April 16, featuring poetry, and April 23, featuring fiction. Look for more details in coming editions.
